## NAVAJO NATION FOOD SERVICE SANITATION CODE & REGULATIONS

Permits must be current and displayed in visible sight during vending hours; expired permits are not allowed.

### **ILLEGAL & RESTRICTED ITEMS**

Alcohol beverages and drug paraphernalia are not allowed & strictly prohibited.

The sales of illegal items such as; counterfeit media, Cds, DVDs, apparel, and all other copyright infringement are not allowed (logos, brands, patent infractions, and copyright breaches).

Weapons: knives, firearms, and any items that depict deadly, lethal, and murderous weapons are strictly prohibited.

The permittee must regulate loud music, interfering with other vendors.

#### LIVESTOCK

Sales of livestock are strictly prohibited unless the vendor has proper documentation, certificates, permits required by Navajo Nation Livestock control laws.

#### **VENDORS**

One or more vendors will be responsible for all business site activities, including; understanding all guidelines implementing policies, health codes, tribal, state, and governmental laws.

# **VENDOR RULES**

Vendors are to park in designated vending spaces. Facemask: Mandatory & required at all times per Navajo Nation Department of Health Guidelines; those not complying will be asked to leave.

Vendors shall pay for space to an authorized representative on Flea Market Day.

No Reservation: first come, first served.

Fee per space:

- Taking up more than one space, the vendor will be assessed appropriately.
- One vehicle per vendor, vendor with food trailer is one vehicle
- Loading and Unloading from time arrival to departure only.
- Only cash payments at this time.

Non-Navajo vendors are required to provide B.I.A. Peddler's Permit.

Vendors are responsible for all items, including waste, debris, and trash. Trash receptacles are located inside the flea market.

Take all used water, cooking oil, etc., with you. Vendor Village does not have a place to dispose of.
